It had come to my notice that a plan has been set out for a proposal of a future housing development of around 45 properties on the land between Stourbridge Road and Crimmond Rise.

I don't think this is at all suitable as the access either via the Stourbridge Road, which is already very congested by traffic and another junction added to this would make it considerably worse, or access by Crimmond Rise which isn't at all suitable for extra traffic, it's difficult enough to see what traffic is coming down the hill as you enter from Belle Vale, with the parked cars on the road, it's also not the best road to get up or down in bad weather.

With the extra houses more traffic could become a nightmare.

Also a big consideration is the loss of wildlife this would cause.

So I would not be in agreement to this.
